Country Selection

Decide upon a country that is best suitable for your requirements considering your background as well as future prospects after completion of your education. Ask knowledgeable **SWS councillor** to suggest a country for you if you cannot take that decision yourself. They are actually the best people to listen to.



Course & Institute Selection

Choose a course & institution that best suits your study preferences. Again considering what you have studied so far and what is best for future prospects upon completion of the course. Ask knowledgeable SWS councillor to suggest a course for you if you cannot take that decision yourself.

Documents Checklist

Learn about the documents required to get you into the course as well as the institution of your choice. SWS Councillor will guide you through the process.





IELTS

Register for your IELTS Examination if you are not eligible for an entry without IELTS. IELTS band requirements vary institution to institution and your admission to a specific course and institution depends on the outcome of your IELTS results.

Admission

Time for you to get enrolled in your preferred course and institution. Just submit your documents to SWS councillor and they will do the rest on your behalf. This is your start towards getting in to the world of global education and opportunities.

Bank Loan Approval (If Needed)

Upon receipt of enrolment into your preferred course and institution, get yourself ready with your finances. Apply for a Student Loan if that is the mode you have decided for your course fees and other expenses. Talk to your preferred bank or ask SWS Councillor and they will guide you through the process.

Visa Documents Check

Get all your documents ready and checked for Visa Application including but not limited to your Educational & Professional Background Documents, Financial Documents, IELTS & other certification, Partnership Documents(if applicable), Course Enrolment Documents. Professional SWS councillors will guide you through the process.





Visa Application & Approval

Final step before you enter the country of your preferred course and institution. Apply for the visa with relevant supporting documentation and visa fees. Get ready to fly before your course start date once visa approved (subject to Immigration approval from the corresponding country).

Air Ticket & Insurance

Book your flight tickets and Insurance as soon as you get your visa approval. Ask SWS Councillor if you wish to as they are able to book these for you.



Departure from India

Prepare yourself for the departure from India and a new beginning in life overseas. Do all your shopping that is needed to start a new life in a foreign country. Study about the country you are going to and that will help you settle down faster. Ask professional SWS staff for the detailed information about the country you are going to. They will be able to guide you through what you need to buy before flying out.

Overseas Country Arrival & Airport Pickup

Fly into the country you have chosen as your new destiny and the land of opportunities for you. Get picked up from the airport by SWS ambassador for a drop off to your accommodation. (Ask SWS Councillor if you wish SWS to arrange these services for you and they will be happy to do so)





Course Induction Day

Get settled down from your Jetlag and get ready for the institution induction day. SWS professionals in the country of your study will help you through all your transportation and/or other requirements to reach your institution.

Bank Account, Income Tax and Local Doctor Registration

SWS professionals in the country of your study will help you through the process required to open up a bank account, Income Tax and Local Doctor Registrations. These are very important steps towards getting your feet into a foreign life.



Part Time Job Search

Gaining practical work experience during your study period is an essential part of your life as a student overseas. Not just for earning money but for you to get yourself familiarize with the environmental, cultural, economical and responsive insight of the society you live in. SWS professionals in the country of your study will help you through the process of getting a part time job.



It is essential to attend classes during your course period to gain enough understanding of what you are studying and is also a requirement to gain your certification. Completing your course on time will get you into the world of professional opportunities available globally.





Post Study Work Visa & a Full time job in the field of your study

Upon completion of your course, you will get a post study work visa to find a suitable job depending on the conditions applied during your first student visa application. Post study work visas vary country to country and also city to city in a specific country. This period is for you to find a full time job in the field of your study to gain practical experience and also a stepping stone towards gaining permanent residency in the country if you wish to.

Permanent Resident Visa (If Approved by Immigration)

Upon getting a full time job in the field of your study and meeting the criteria set by immigration authorities of the country of your overseas study, you may apply for a permanent resident visa. Grant of the visa is strictly subject to immigration scrutiny set out through various factors specifically applied to a visa application.



Citizenship

After certain years of you getting a permanent residence in a country of your overseas study, you may apply for citizenship of that country if you wish to. This period varies country to country and grant of the citizenship is strictly subject to scrutiny set out through various factors specifically applied to a citizenship application.
